**Resolution Adopting Additional Routes to the Town of Jackson
UTV/ATV Routes and Operation Ordinance**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to create routes and rules for operation of Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV) and All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV) within the Town of Jackson, Adams County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, following due consideration of the recreational and economic impact value of connecting trails and the experience of other communities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, the Town of Jackson has created this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Town of Jackson did appear with other persons of said Town of Jackson, Adams County, Wisconsin at a meeting held on 5/14/19 at the Jackson Town Hall, Oxford, WI, to hear statements for and against adding 6th Ct, south of Freedom Lane to Gale Ave and the Town of Jackson's specified WI Department of Transportation's sections west on Gale Ave to the current list of approved UTV/ATV routes, and after evaluating all data and evidence presented at the meeting, the Town Board of the Town of Jackson moved to recommend adding the additional routes as follow:

- 1) 6th Ct South of Freedom Lane to Gale Ave
- 2) Town of Jackson's portions of Gale Ave both East and West of 6th Ct

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF JACKSON BOARD SUPERVISORS:

This Resolution approving the additional UTV/ATV routes as listed shall become effective in the Town of Jackson upon passage and posting.
