

# Garbage & Recycling Pick-up Guidelines

## How to place garbage & recycling at the curb

- Place all recyclable materials loosely in a reusable bin.
- **Do not** place recyclables in plastic bags.
- **Do not** place garbage in your recycling bin.
- Place household garbage in a plastic bag and into a reusable container.
- Bulky items like furniture and scrap metal can be brought to our drop-off site, but not placed at the curb.
- Flatten boxes and cut to no larger than 3 ft x 3 ft in size and secured on windy days using a brown paper bag.
- Shredded paper should be placed in a brown paper bag, stapled closed and placed in your bin.
- Keep recycling at least 4 ft away from garbage. The best solution is to place your material on opposite sides of your driveway.
- Reusable garbage & recycling bins must not be over 33 gallons in size or weigh more than 50 pounds when set at the curb.
- Durable recycling bins are available to purchase at Adams County Solid Waste & Recycling for \$8.50.

If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be declared the **official county holiday**.

If a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be declared the **official county holiday**.
